About Our Camp

The Tall Oaks camp is nestled near the Manistee National Forest, and located on the beautiful Big Star Lake in southern Lake County. With its natural and serene wooded setting, our camp offers fun and excitement to all of its guests.



Our wonderful facilities include a large and completely furnished kitchen with a dining hall that can seat up to 260 people. Our chapel can seat up to 75 people, perfect for services and private reflections. We also have a community type restroom and shower house, but especially a large playground for children to play on. We also proudly have sandy beaches, and a wonderful lakeside view.

We currently have 11 cabins available with 7 to 9 single and bunk beds in each cabin. We also offer 40 camping sites, with many of our shaded sites having access to water, as well as electricity.

Also, on a limited basis we offer 6 cottages available with a view of the lake, and containing private restrooms and/or showers. These cabins usually vary from 1 to 3 rooms in size.
